We also ask each person to bring an unwrapped book for a child aged 10 or younger.

The books will be given to mothers of young children in the Women's Correctional Institute in Black Mountain. Each mother will record herself reading a book and then send the recording and the book to her child. The child will play the recording and follow along in the book as the child listens to his or her mother read the story.

Directions: Take the Charlotte St Exit off I-240 in Asheville. Coming from the east, turn left onto Charlotte St at the light at the end of the exit ramp. Coming from the west, turn right onto Charlotte St. Go to the bottom of the hill and turn left onto College Street. Go one block, and turn left onto Town Mountain Rd. Go about 2.3 miles, and turn left onto Patton Mountain Rd. Go 0.2 mile up Patton Mountain Rd. The Residence is on the right.

Please carpool if you can. Parking is limited at the Governor's Residence.
