



How to Request an Absentee Ballot

Receiving an Absentee Ballot gives you the option to mail in your ballot OR to vote-in-person at the polls during Early Voting or Election Day. Request your absentee ballot NOW. Ballots will be sent out starting September 4th.

- 1** Complete a Request for an Absentee Ballot by going to the NC State Board of Elections website [HERE](#).
- 2** Mail, drop off, fax, or scan/email your Request for an Absentee Ballot form to Election services in your county.
